

# DIY PROJECTS

## SEED BOMBS

4oz Air Dry Clay  
1oz Potting Soil  
1oz Flower Seeds  
Water



NOTE: Make sure to mix everything thoroughly. Making wildflower seed bombs is really easy as long as this is done.

1. Spread out the clay to be large enough to pour the dirt on it. Doesn't matter what size - just make sure there's plenty of room for the dirt and everything else to pile on top of it.
2. Pour the dirt on the clay and then pour the seeds on top of it.
3. Fold together and then knead until the mixture is thoroughly mixed together. Carefully add a little water to make it come together (you don't want it too gloopy).
4. Roll out into a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch log and make a cut every  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch. Roll each section into a small, truffle-sized seed balls.
5. Let sit in the sun to dry out for at least three hours.
6. Toss where you'd like the flowers to bloom.
